PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Y(OUR) CALLING...

"And Christ died for all, so that those who live might live no longer for themselves, but for him who died and was raised for them. From now on, therefore, we regard no one from a human point of view...Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation... entrusting the message of reconciliation to us.

So we are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us..."

— 2nd Corinthians 5:14-21

It is said that there is one command that Jesus gave that we, as Lutherans, follow quite well. It is Jesus' command to the man healed of leprosy in Mark 1:44, "See that you don't tell this to anyone." Or, it is said that we follow the example of the women in Mark 16:8 who hear that Jesus is risen and respond with, "They said nothing to anyone, because they were afraid." Both references are intended to be a joke - a way in which we poke fun at ourselves and our ethnic heritage of being rather soft-spoken about sharing the Gospel and witnessing through our words. However, in reality it is not a joke, nor is it a joking matter.

In Christ, we have been given the gift of new life with all that it entails: forgiveness, reconciliation, healing, strength in tough times, hope, peace in the midst of trouble, grace, eternal life, and so much more. God in Christ Jesus is our source of all life - truly our reason for being. And yet, we struggle to find a way to put this into words. Like the women at the empty tomb, perhaps we do not share the hope we've found because we, too, are afraid. We are afraid of rejection. Afraid that it won't come out right. Afraid that we don't have a story to share. Afraid to witness beyond our actions with our words.

Yet, the reality is that God has been at work in our lives continually - bringing light out of darkness; hope out of despair; healing out of brokenness; new life out of death. When many of us look at our lives, we may feel that we don't have a powerful faith story to share, therefore, our testimony is not valid. However, if you look at your life and ask yourself, "When has God been at work?" You will find that God is a main character in your story, too. Therefore, why not share the hope you have in Christ with those around you?

At our annual meeting in January, 2nd Corinthians 5:14-21 was the heart of our devotions. Saint Paul writes that we are new creations in Christ. Paul also writes that we are ambassadors of Christ. Each one of us is called to be a minister, witness, or ambassador of Jesus Christ in every aspect of our lives: work, school, home, and play.

In seminary, a beloved professor of mine worded it differently. Borrowing from Martin Luther's image of us as "little Christs," Professor Rollie Martinson said, "God calls us to be Jesus with skin on for others in our lives." Although it may appear to be a daunting task, what is one place or relationship in your life where you can focus on being "Jesus with skin on"? My hope and prayer is that as we cling to the one who is our reason for hope and being - we also cling to those around us and pray for the courage to be Christ's ambassadors in all corners of our world.




