# PASTOR'S MESSAGE

"To Pray is to Laugh, Whistle – DANCE on happy feet Sing! **SHOUT** and jump! higher than ever before.

But it is also to whisper – Wonder...

Stumble in dark places. Cry... SCREAM

Or just hold a tired head in tired hands and wait ...

**PRAYER** is our tired reaching out to the ONE who holds us closer and loves us more than we would dare imagine." − Greta Schrumm

#### Christ is Risen! He is risen indeed!

Note: we looked at Greta Schrum's description of prayer last month, but it is a perfect image to see again in light of the Risen Christ's presence drawing us to connect in prayer with God.

In the season of Easter, this resurrection good news is our good news and hope. As the earth around us slowly springs to life, so too, does our spirit.

Throughout Lent, we focused on Psalm 23, the Psalm of the Good Shepherd. Together, with our brothers and sisters in Christ from Bethlehem Lutheran --- we journeyed to the cross and empty tomb together. Each week, we set down another piece of baggage or burden as we lightened our load, just as author Max Lucado urged us to do in our reflection book, Traveling Light. Each week the pile of burdens and baggage grew --- and by Good Friday, the burdens were gone, nailed to the cross and gone for good.

Max Lucado wrote about the gifts of Psalm 23 --- especially when it inspired us to turn to the Good Shepherd and pray. Prayer is one of the key ways we continue to lay our baggage and burdens at Jesus' feet and experience God's peace and comfort as He takes the burdens from us. In much the same way – we are now in the season of Easter. Easter is not just one

Sunday --- it lasts for 7 weeks! Why? Because we need Resurrection Good News each and every day --- and we need that good news to truly take hold of our lives.

We need the good news of the cross and empty tomb as it meets us exactly where we are and brings the crucified and risen One to you and me. The reality is — Lenten theme or not --- we need our burdens lifted each and every day, not just as a special focus six weeks out of the year.

Isn't part of our spiritual journey... even our life journey, the reality that God is continually at work in our lives --- molding us, shaping us, transforming us, and reforming us — again and again? Isn't that what happens in prayer? Isn't that what life is all about --- God rushing into our brokenness and bringing healing? God brings light into darkness and life out of death. If that is our story --- and it is!

Then, let's shout it from the rooftops --- "Come to Immanuel Lutheran Church in Atwater, where we're not perfect and we're proud of it!" Because we may not be perfectly put together or stronger than anything --- but God in Christ Jesus is. God in Christ Jesus enters into our beautiful, sinful, joy-filled, broken and put back together community and breathes His life into us again and again. The One who holds us closer than we would dare imagine, breathes the understanding and comfort of the crucified Lord into our struggles,

Even better, this One, is the lover and leader of our congregation, our family of God, our body of Christ that is Immanuel Lutheran Church. This One is the lover and leader of our very lives. Better still... this One calls to us, each and every one of us and beckons us to draw near, to open up and pour out all the joys, challenges and struggles of this life. This One invites us to be still, to quiet the busy, racing pace of our lives and listen... listen to the love, mercy, grace, forgiveness, hope and new life of God in Christ Jesus. As our hearts turn and speak with our Creator, as our ears turn and listen to the Living God --- we are renewed... filled... reformed... made new.

Prayer is God's invitation to us to crawl into the lap of God, raise our arms like a child – and be lifted up.
