2008 Scholarship Guidelines

The Lake Superior Chapter of the Society of Explosives Engineers is pleased to offer scholarships in the amounts up to \$1000 to deserving undergraduate students actively pursuing engineering degrees and high school seniors who are intending to pursue engineering degrees. Selection of students to be awarded scholarships will be made by the Chapter's Scholarship Committee. The Scholarship Program is an important part of the Lake Superior Chapter's annual mission, and all engineering students engaged in studies toward careers in the mining industry or other engineering fields are encouraged to apply.

RULES AND PROCEDURES

- 1) You must be majoring in an engineering or mining related field in an accredited program.
- 2) You must be a citizen of the United States.
- 3) You must submit an essay that comments on your career objectives.
- 4) Each student should arrange to have at least one letter of recommendation **independently submitted** to The Lake Superior Chapter of the ISEE. The recommendation should come from an instructor or professor, a former or current employer, or from a person in the mining industry.
- 5) Submittal of a transcript is helpful.
- 6) Daughters and sons of ***Board Members*** of The Lake Superior Chapter of the ISEE are not eligible for this scholarship.

- 7) The application, essay, optional transcript, and independently submitted letter of recommendation should be mailed to:
