"These words Jesus spoke, and lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said, 'Father, the hour has come; glorify Your Son, so that Your Son also may glorify You, even as You have given Him power over all flesh, so that He (Jesus) should give Eternal Life to as many as You have given to Him. And this is Life Eternal, that they might know You the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom You have sent. I have glorified You on the earth; I have finished the work which You gave Me to do. And now, O Father, glorify Me with Your own Self with the Glory which I had with You before the world existed. I manifested Your Name unto the Men (His disciples) whom You gave to Me out of the world. They were Yours, and You gave them to Me; and they have kept Your word. Now they have known that all things whatsoever You have given to Me are of You. For I have given unto them the words which You gave to Me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from You, and they have believed that You sent Me.' "(John 17:1-6-8)

I manifested: from the Greek word <u>Ephanerosa</u> which means: <u>I manifested; I revealed;</u> from **phaneroo**: to <u>enlighten</u>, to make visible, to make clear, to make known, to reveal, to manifest, to make clear or obvious to the eye or mind. In context: Jesus manifested the Father's will, mercy, love, and grace, ..., for mankind, through His miracles, teachings, exhortations, warnings, etc..

Your Name: from the Greek words <u>sou to onomax</u> which mean: <u>your name</u>; from **onoma**: a proper name; or <u>a name</u> in the sense of character, fame, or reputation; the manifestation or revelation of someone's character, or essence. Jesus did, and taught, many things in His Father's Name; thereby manifesting the the character, essence, and love of the Father towards people.

Unto the Men: from the Greek words *tois anthropois* which mean: <u>unto the men;</u> referring specifically to the disciples of Jesus.

Whom You Gave: from the Greek words <u>hous edokas moi</u> which mean: <u>whom you-have-given to-me</u>; again, referring specifically to the disciples whom the Father has given to Jesus.

Out of the World: from the Greek words <u>sek tou kosmou</u> which mean: <u>out of this world;</u> referring specifically to disciples, of Jesus, who have been delivered and rescued out of this present evil and sinful world.

Concerning His disciples, Jesus also prayed to the Father the following:

"At that time Jesus answered and said, 'I thank You, O Father, <u>Lord of Heaven and Earth</u>, because You have hid these things from the wise and prudent, and has revealed them unto babes. Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight. All things <u>are delivered unto Me</u> by <u>My Father</u>; and no man knows the Son, except the Father; nor does any man know the Father, except the Son, **and to whomever the Son wills to reveal** *Him*." (Matt. 11:25-27)

Jesus had previously expressed the same desire to His disciples:

"Henceforth, I do not call you servants; for the servant does not know what his Lord is doing: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known unto you." (John 15:15)

I have made known: from the Greek word <u>egnorisa</u> which means: <u>I-have-made-known;</u> from *gnorizo*: to come to know, to make known, to declare, to reveal. This was especially accomplished through the teachings of Christ Jesus.

He Manifested the Father's Name to His disciples

John, the apostle of Jesus, confirmed that Jesus has thoroughly revealed the Father:

"No man has seen God at any time; the **Only Begotten Son** (Jesus), who <u>is in the bosom of the Father</u>, **He has completely-declared Him**." (John 1:18)

Jesus manifested the 'Name' of the Father by teaching them about the Father. Please consider the following 'manifestations' concerning the Father spoken by Jesus:

"Take heed that you do not your alms before men, to be seen of them: otherwise you have no reward of **your Father** who is in heaven; ... and **your Father** who sees in secret shall Himself reward you openly." (Matthew 6:1-4)

"But you, when you pray, enter into your closet, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret shall reward you openly." (Matthew 6:6)

"If you forgive men their trespasses, **your heavenly Father** will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will **your Father** forgive your trespasses." (Matt. 6:15)

"Be you therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful." (Luke 6:36)

"And they came to Jerusalem; and Jesus went into the Temple, and began to cast out those who sold and bought in the Temple, and (He) overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of those who sold doves; and would not allow that any man should carry any vessel through the Temple. And <u>He taught</u>, saying unto them, 'Is it not written, *My house (the Father's House) shall be called by all nations the House of Prayer?* ' (Isaiah 56:7) But you have made it a den of thieves." (Mark 11:15-17)

"Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask for bread, will he give him a stone? Or if he ask for a fish, will he give him a serpent? If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him?" (Matthew 7:9-11)

"But I say unto you, <u>Love your enemies</u>, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who despitefully use you, and persecute you; so that <u>you may be the children of your Father who is in Heaven</u>; for <u>He makes His sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust." (Matthew 5:44-45)</u>

"Be you therefore perfect, even as your Father who is in heaven is perfect." (Matthew 5:48)

"Take no thought, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or, 'What shall we drink?' or, 'With what shall we be clothed?' For all these things do the Gentiles seek; for **your heavenly Father** knows that you need all these things. But seek first the Kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you." (Matthew 6:31-33)

"The (Samaritan) woman said unto Him (Jesus), 'Sir, I perceive that You are a prophet. Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and You say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship.' Jesus said to her, 'Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming, when you shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father. You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship; for salvation is of the Jews. But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth; for the Father seeks such people to worship Him. God is a Spirit; and those who worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth. The woman said unto Him, I' know that Messiah is coming, who is called Christ; when He is comes, He will tell us all things.' Jesus said unto her, 'I who speaks unto you am He" (John 4:19-24)

He Manifested the Father's Name to His disciples

Jesus summed up the importance of His teachings that He received from the Father, which revealed the Father as being their source, as follows:

"Therefore whoever hears these words of Mine, and does them, I will liken him unto a wise man, who built his house upon a rock; and when the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it did not fall; for it was founded upon rock. But every one who hears these words of Mine, and does not do them, shall be likened unto a foolish man, who built his house upon the sand; and the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell; and great was the fall of it. And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at His teaching; for He taught them as one having Authority (as from the Father), and not as the scribes." (Matthew 7:24-29)

Jesus manifested the Name of the Father through the miracles that He performed!

"And it came to pass the day after, that He went into a city called Nain; and many of His disciples went with Him, and many people. Now when He came near to the gate of the city, behold, there was a dead man being carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow; and many people of the city were with her. And when the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her, and said unto her, 'Weep not.' And He came and touched the bier: and those who carried him stood still. And He said, 'Young man, I say unto you, Arise. And he who was dead sat up, and began to speak; and <u>He</u> delivered him unto his mother. <u>And there came a fear on all;</u> and <u>they glorified God</u>, saying, 'A <u>Great Prophet</u> (Jesus) has risen up among us;' and that '<u>God has visited His people</u>.' " (Luke 7:11-16)

"And, behold, they brought to Him a man, a paralytic, lying on a bed; and Jesus seeing their faith said unto the paralytic; 'Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven.' And, behold, certain of the scribes said within themselves, 'This man blasphemes.' And Jesus knowing their thoughts said, 'Why think you evil in your hearts? For what is easier, to say, 'Your sins be forgiven;' or to say, 'Arise, and walk?' But that you may know that the Son of Man (Jesus) has power on earth to forgive sins; then He said to the paralytic, 'Arise, take up your bed, and go unto your house.' And he arose, and departed to his house. But when the multitudes saw it, they marveled, and glori fied God, who had given such power unto men. (Matthew 9:2-8)

"And great multitudes came unto Him (to Jesus), having with them those that were lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and He healed them; insomuch that the multitude marveled, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see; and they glorified the God of Israel. (Matthew 15:29-31)
