1960: Born in Saint Ansgar's Hospital, Moorhead, MN to William J and Kathleen Beeson, the youngest of 7.

1961: Moved from Dilworth, MN to Fargo, ND

1965: Broke my leg.

1967-1975: Holy Spirit Catholic School, 1st Communion in 2nd grade, Confirmation in 5th, Altar boy from 6th to 8th

1975-1979: Shanley High School, Senior Mathematics Award, interested in Drama and Chess. Upon graduation, stopped going to Church. Just was not interested. Did not stop believing.

1979-1980: Moorhead State. Campus radio station was my extracurricular activity.

1980: Moved to Minneapolis and attended Brown institute for Radio broadcasting. Worked for 2 years at a restaurant named "The Restaurant."

1981: Solved Rubik's Cube

1982: Got my first and only radio gig in Carrington, ND. Was fired six weeks later. Moved back to Fargo.

1983-1986: Joined the Army. Was a Medic stationed at Fort Dix, NJ.

1986: Honorably discharged from the Army and moved back to Minneapolis.

1986-1999: Worked full time continuously at a plasma center in Minneapolis as a Phlebotomist and a QA Supervisor. Perfect attendance record.

Continued to work full time while doing all the other activities in that timeline.

1988: Found my faith again and started going back to Church again at St. Olaf in Minneapolis. That led me to volunteer as a Eucharistic minister, Lector, counter of collection, and a part time job as usher/ security.

1989-1991: Minneapolis Community College: Associate's degree in Accounting (Night School)

1992-1996: Metropolitan State University: Bachelor's degree in Accounting.

1995: Felt God was calling me to the priesthood, but my will persisted.

1997-1999: Accountemps.

1998: Finally gave in to God's call to the Priesthood and called the vocation office. The first person I talked to at the vocation office was Fr. Stan Mader.

1999-2005: Seminary. Teaching Parish: St. John the Baptist New Brighton. Ordained in a class of 15 for the Archdiocese.

2005-2008: Associate Pastor at Saint Stephen's in Anoka. 2008-2009: Associate Pastor at Holy Spirit in Saint Paul. 2009-July 13, 2014: Pastor at Saint John Vianney in South Saint Paul

July 14, 2014-? Pastor Saint Pius V in Cannon Falls and Saint Joseph in Miesville.

Our local school board has been debating whether our school should teach creationism as part of its science program. Does the church have a position on this?

A

Many news programs have covered debates and discussions similar to the one you mention. The question is complicated and can be answered several ways. First, there is a difference between "Intelligent Design" and creationism. The first admits to the creative power of God; the other turns the Bible into a bad science textbook! Both of these stand in contrast to Darwin's theory of evolution, which sees higher forms of life evolving from lower forms. The problems with this idea we will leave to the scientists to explain.

Creationism, however, requires a fundamentalist understanding of Genesis, which contradicts the church's teaching on how we interpret Scripture. Genesis was written to explain a religious truth, not a scientific one: God created the world. The details are not as important, nor are they always understandable to humankind. Instead, the mystery of creation is explained in a story that people will remember. Whether God created the world in seven days does not really matter.

The church teaches that we never need to fear the truth. Truth is one. Theology and science, if truthful, will not contradict one another. The only thing that truth cancels is falsehood. The only theory of a religious nature that would be acceptable to Catholics is that God is the Creator—in whatever mysterious way God acted.

## 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In our religious special education classes this past year, we discussed miracles with the kids. But before the year began, each of us catechists was given a "miracle box," a simple wooden box with an inscription on top, asking us to look deeper-to look deeper at our kids with special needs, for in them we would find the miracle of God's true love, a love given freely to the innocent and shared with us. Jesus' parables are widely known, and most of us can recall them in some detail. But often, we fail to look deeper into their meaning and accept the challenge to apply them to our own lives. As with the parable of the sower and the seed, do we listen to God's word at Mass or are we distracted or uninterested? How many of us can actually recall the readings or the pastor's homily even a few hours after we hear them?

Today, please accept the challenge of looking deeper into the word of God. # Mission for the Diocese of Jaffna

The Catholic Church in Jaffna, Sri Lanka appeals for help to provide and improve the Education of the children affected by the civil war that raged the country for over thirty years.

Sri Lanka, an island nation on the Indian Ocean, smaller than the state of Minnesota in US, is a land of four religions and three languages. Budhism, Hinduism, Islam and Christianity are the religions practiced there and Sinhala, Tamil an English are spoken. History records that it has not been that easy for the different cultural groups to live together as one nation owing to the alleged discriminatory political visions in the country and denial of equal opportunity for all the culturally different people. Owing to the denial of equal rights to the minorities, a ferocious civil war erupted in the country and that lasted for thirty years. Thus, many live have been lost and destruction has been enormous. Although, the war ended about four years ago, yet no political solution has been put in place. People are very much relieved that there is no more war and the people have begun to rebuild their lives and thus, this is a time of reconciliation and rehabilitation.

The Catholic is very actively involved in many reconstruction and rehabilitation projects not excluding the field of education. It is the need of the time to enhance the education of the war affected children in many parts of the country.

In this linguistically polarized country, the language of English has become a link to bridge the two linguistic groups. The minority community needs to communicate with those of the majority for its survival and the need of the knowledge of the English language is a must.

The civil war and other reasons caused lot of damage to the infrastructure in the field of education especially in the rural and remote areas of the Catholic dioceses of Jaffna and Mannar and as a result there is a dearth of qualified English teachers in the rural schools of the regions.

The Catholic church decided to establish an institution called 'ENGLISH LANGUAGE SCHOOL' and to run an English Training Program for the Advanced and Ordinary Levels completed students, recruited from the rural areas and train them to be primary teachers in their own villages. Thus the trained candidates could either work through the school system or outside with the help of the parish community.

In fact, this Training Program has already commenced and the first batch of students has completed their program and the recruitment for the second batch is underway. That program will begin on Sunday, August 24, 2014.

This residential Training program lasts for nine months for 35 students in a batch. No fee is charged from the students, instead everything including weekly transport cost to return home is provided. To run this program for onetime, the English Language School requires about 22,000 US Dollars.

Through this English Language Training Program, we will be able to reach out to numerous rural children of all religions, to empower them in their English Education that will put them on equal footing with the children of the cities.

The Catholic Church will much appreciate any help rendered to this project to assist the needy and war affected children in the northern part of Sri Lanka.

(Fr. Edwin Savundra, a retired priest from the Archdiocese of Saint Paul an Minneapolis, is the coordinator of this project in the Diocese of Jaffna, Sri Lanka. He was a professor of Philosophy at the University of Saint Thomas and served the parishes of Marysburg, Cleveland, Faribault and Rush City before retiring.)
